OCWA Session Councillor Foster provided a brief update on a Session Council had with OCWA. He advised that he feels Council is satisfied that the Town is protected with respect to our drinking water and Blue Green Algae and Milfoil. Councillor R. Duplessis advised that Keith Stringer of OCWA did a great job at the Council session and would like a Thank you letter sent. **Nelson Creek Culvert** Councillor R. Duplessis requested some clarification on the Nelson Creek Culvert Project with respect to the lack of notification provided to the Public regarding the Jacklin Rd closure. The Assistant Manager of Public Works advised that the contractor assured Staff that the notifications were and would be provided. A couple days later Staff was notified by residents of the area that the road was closed and there was no notification. Staff will work with the contractor and Project Manager to determine where the issues lie and ensure this does not happen in the future. July 1st Fireworks Councillor R. Duplessis inquired if the Fireworks have been rescheduled. The CAO advised that a couple dates have been discussed but no date has been set at this time. Councillor R. Duplessis asked where the Fireworks are stored. Staff advised that they would get this information and provide it to Council.
