

TOWNSHIP OF SABLES-SPANISH RIVERS

- Waste Management Program Description

Curbside pick-up:

The Contractor shall provide residential and commercial curbside pick-up of bagged residential garbage. Currently pickup is every Thursday.

Residences shall be entitled to weekly pick up of two untagged bags of garbage. All residential garbage in excess of two bags shall bear an approved Township tag.

“Commercial” is defined as any operation that pays commercial taxes to the Township. Commercial operations shall be entitled to weekly pick up of eight untagged bags of garbage. All commercial garbage in excess of eight bags shall bear an approved Township tag.

Should the Contractor perform services for any individual or commercial operator exclusive of the agreement with the Township, the Contractor shall remit to the Township all applicable tipping fees pursuant to the current approved landfill tipping fee schedule. Fees shall be remitted at least once each month with documentation stating the source of fees generated and the volume of such waste deposited in the Municipal landfill site.

Garbage that is generated from within the municipality only, shall be deposited in the municipal landfill site.

Recyclables:

1. The Contractor shall provide regular pick-up service of recyclable materials in the Township of Sables-Spanish Rivers once every week on Thursdays, alternating collection of recyclable materials on a two-week schedule as follows:
 - a) One week will be fibers (paper and cardboard), and the next week will be commingle (cans, plastic, glass), the schedule to be agreed upon in consultation between the Contractor and the Corporation.
 - b) Recyclable materials from commercial operations shall be picked up on the same schedule as residences, pursuant to subsection a).
2. Recyclable materials currently include **mixed paper** (newspapers, advertisement flyers, office paper, magazines, paper bags, junk mail); **cardboard** (boxboard, flattened cardboard); **glass containers**; **metals** (foil, pop cans, food containers; **plastics** #1 through to and include #6, with the exception of aerosol cans, “foam peanuts” and “packaging foam”).
3. The Contractor is encouraged to increase the variety of materials eligible for recycling and shall advise the Corporation of any such increase.

Waste Transfer Sites:

There are four waste transfer sites throughout the Township, one being seasonal use only. These sites are for residential garbage based on the 2-bag limit for curbside, as well as the applicable weekly recyclable materials. The Contractor shall empty garbage bins and pick up the recyclables

every week. The Township reserves the right to alter the location of the waste transfer sites and the number of containers located therein should it be deemed necessary by the Township.

The Webbwood landfill site is closed as an active landfill, and is used as a depot/transfer site for residents on West Branch Road. These residents are able to access the site every Sunday to dispose of their residential waste and recycling. This site requires pickup of all waste and recycling before the following Sunday. Waste picked up at all transfer sites is transported by the Contractor to the Tennyson landfill site.

Landfill Backfill, Cover and Compaction:

The current Contractor provides backfill, cover and compaction service to the Tennyson landfill site once each week on the day that collected waste is deposited in the landfill site as soon thereafter as is practical. The Contractor provides all equipment necessary for the backfill, cover and compaction function, and provides cover material as necessary upon request of the Township at the cost agreed upon. Equipment includes landfill compactor and loader.

COST FOR SERVICE

The Township shall remunerate the Contractor for services provided in accordance with this Agreement using the following for the base year 20___;

- Garbage Collection and Disposal \$_____ per annum
- Collection and Disposal of Recyclable Materials _____ per annum
- Backfill, Compaction and Cover _____ per annum
- Cover material delivered _____ per cubic yard

All costs are exclusive of applicable taxes

Costs for service are subject to annual cost of living increase as per consumer price index as of January of each year, as invoiced by the Contractor.
